Ryegate Pit. The Board advised Nelson to place the waste block on the Town's property to contain the sandpile. Sand will be hauled in as time permits. Ryegate purchased ½ ownership of the roadside mower with the Town of Danville. The roadsides will be mowed several times throughout the summer. Bid Opening for paving a section of Peacham/Groton Rd and Stone Rd will be at the June 12th meeting.

*Addition to Agenda: William Elder presented his resignation at the Planning & Zoning meeting May 15th and he will send it to the Select Board. The vacancy will then be posted, the Board will then appoint someone to fill the vacancy.
