

# WARNING

The legal voters of the Town of Ryegate, Vermont, are hereby warned and notified to meet at the Ryegate Town Office on March 7, 2017, between the hours of ten o'clock (10:00 A.M.) in the forenoon, at which time the polls will open, and seven o'clock (7:00 P.M.) in the afternoon, at which time the polls will close, to vote by Australian ballot on the following business, viz:

**Article 1:** Shall the Town of Ryegate, Vermont, authorize the Selectboard to borrow a sum of money in an amount not to exceed Seventy Four Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Nine Dollars (\$74, 999.00) for a term not to exceed Twenty (20) years for the purpose of financing the cost of renovations at the wastewater treatment facility, including filter bed replacement, septic tank filters and resetting of sampling wells.

Voting under this Article shall be by ballot in the following form:

## BALLOT TOWN OF RYEGATE, VERMONT WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY BORROWING

Shall the Town of Ryegate, Vermont, authorize the Selectboard to borrow a sum of money in an amount not to exceed Seventy Four Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Nine Dollars (\$74,999.00) for a term not to exceed Twenty (20) years for the purpose of financing the cost of renovations at the wastewater treatment facility, including filter bed replacement, septic tank filters and resetting of sampling wells.
